**Subject: Conduct of online course on TM / PoT and AITT examination of RPL
under Craft Instructor Training Scheme (CITS) – Reg.**

Sir

With reference to Guidelines of RPL under CITS and this office letter . **MSDE-18011/DGT/2017-TTC (Pt-III)** dated 11.02.2019 regarding Reforms in ALL India Trade Test conducted under the aegis of NCVT, the competent authority has approved the Registration/Examination fee of Rs. 3000/ per candidate to be received from the candidate appearing in AITT of RPL under CITS. The fee has to be submitted to the concerned INSTI where candidate is registered for test and original documents verification.


The fee has to be collected only from the candidate who is declared eligible to appear in exam after original document verification. The hall ticket should be issued to the candidates only after ensuring the deposit of Rs. 3000/ (Rs. Three Thousands only) as Registration/Examination fee of per candidate at NSTI in form of Cash / Demand draft in favour of DDO, NSTI.

The Registration/Examination fee collected from the candidates should be treated as revenue of the Institute and to be deposited in consolidated fund of India as Government Receipt.

The said Registration/Examination fee of Rs. 3000/- per candidate is valid only for one exam. The candidate has to resubmit the exam fee for every cycle of registration / examination for issuance of hall ticket from the concerned NSTI.

In view of the above, you are requested to do the needful at your end and communicate this information to all the concerned.

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Subject: Guidelines regarding experience certificate in respect of online registration of candidates for AITT examination of RPL under Craft Instructor Training Scheme (CITS) – Reg.

Sir

With reference to Guidelines of RPL under CITS and this office letter no.MSDE-18012/05/RPL- CITS/2018-TTC dated 11.02.2019 on subject matter and representation from various State Directorates regarding non eligibility of contractual instructors serving in Govt ITIs for RPL due to non availability of GPF/EPF statement.


The competent authority has relaxed the eligibility criteria for contractual instructors serving in Govt ITIs and decided that in case of non availability of GPF/EPF statement of contractual instructors in Govt ITI applying for RPL, an experience certificate issued from the Principal of govt ITIs where instructor is working at present may be considered to certify the experience of Instructor regarding teaching in ITI in place of GPF/EPF statement.

If any instructor has worked as contractual instructor in more than one govt ITI in last 03 years, then the certificate of experience should be issued from present Govt ITI principal only.

This relaxation is only to the contractual instructor working in Govt ITIs and applying for RPL under CITS.

In view of the above, you are requested to do the needful at your end and communicate this information to all concerned.
